

PUSH Grant Applications Now Open. Apply Now!

Grants available in two tiers, \$2,500 and \$5,000. The total fund has reached over \$200,000 made possible by community partners such as: *Main St. Ventures, First Financial Bank, Kroger Co., the Haile Foundation, Cincinnati Development Fund*, and host of online supporters. Grants will be able to support 100-150 Hamilton County minority-owned businesses and can be used for: restocking inventory, cash for initial payroll, revenue generating expenses, business model changes or pivot, rent or lease payments.

Applications for PUSH Grants are now being accepted to provide these businesses with the short-term funding to stay afloat and able to restart quickly. Our minority business owners are also community leaders, educators, and so much more. The PUSH Grants application process is unique in many ways; inclusive application process, assists businesses who may not qualify for federal loans, PPP, or other funding, and grants for home based businesses, 1099 contractors, and e commerce based companies. The first round of applications are from May 27th- June 5th. >>> Apply Now!

Businesses applying for The PUSH Grant must meet certain eligibility requirements that include:

- 1. African American or minority-owned for-profit business (51%)
- 2. In business for 6 months or more
- 3. Business is located within Hamilton County
- 4. Business has 10 or fewer FTE employees
- 5. Business has revenues of \$500,000 or less
- 6. Demonstration of need
- 7. Strategy for stability
- 8. In good standing with the State of Ohio
